

Bachelor Degree Programs (4 years)

At college you must meet the admission requirements for university (i.e., minimum of six Gr. 12 U/M courses including program prerequisites)

Please Note: You may need to apply for some degree programs through the [Ontario University Application Center](#) (not OCAS). Be sure to do your research because each program and college may vary.

Collaborative (Joint College - University Program)

(Diploma + Degree simultaneously)

i.e., Nursing. You must meet the admission requirements for university before you can apply (6 Grade 12 U/M Courses) and **usually application through [OUAC](#) is required**. *Complete thorough research because each program and college may vary.*







Academic Requirements

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), or equivalent, or mature student status (19 years or older)
- Grade 12 English (C or U), or equivalent (minimum grade required), or take the **Centennial College English Skills Assessment for Admission**
- Grade 11 Mathematics (C, M, or U) or Grade 12 Mathematics (C, or U), or equivalent (minimum grade required), or take a **Centennial College Math Skills Assessment for Admission**

Additional Requirements

- **English language proficiency**

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

- International students who have not completed their last 3 or 4 years of full-time studies in English may be required to provide a language proficiency test score. *(could vary by school)*

Refer to the specific college you plan to attend to see which test they accept and what score they require *(i.e., Duolingo, TOEFL, IELTS, etc.)*

*These can be different at different schools

*Select a maximum of **5** college program choices with
no more than **3** choices from one college .*

The most common required courses for admission to college Diploma Programs are:

Grade 12 English (ENG4C) Grade 12 Math (MAP4C)

Grade 11 or 12 Sciences (SBI3C, SCH4C, SPH4C)

*Admission requirements vary from college to college even if title of program is the same

*Students with U/M level courses will still meet C level admission requirements





Paying for College: Tuition and Financial Assistance

Although college tuition costs are typically lower than university, there are variations from college to college and from program to program.

Average cost of tuition for **one academic year** in an Ontario college program:

- Diploma Programs - \$2,400
- Graduate Certificate Programs - \$3,600
- Bachelor's Degree Programs - \$6,100
- Collaborative Programs - \$5,000

You can also expect an average of \$800 in ancillary fees (student activity fees, athletic fees, health insurance, etc.) and \$1,300 for books and supplies.

Please note that these figures do not include living costs, such as rent, utilities and transportation.



IMPORTANT DATES

- **OCTOBER, 2025** – ONLINE APPLICATION OPENS for programs beginning in the following academic year. You may create an account and [begin your application](#).
- **NOVEMBER 1, 2024** – EARLIEST OFFER DATE. Earliest date that colleges may begin to send offers of admission to programs for the upcoming academic year. Offers continue until programs are filled.
- **FEBRUARY 1, 2025** – EQUAL CONSIDERATION DATE. Apply on or before this date to receive equal consideration for admission to programs starting the following fall. After this date, colleges enter applications on a first come, first served basis until programs are full.

Note that applications to **Highly Competitive Programs** must be received by this date to be considered.

- **MAY 1, 2025** – DEADLINE TO CONFIRM OFFER OF ADMISSION. Must accept your offer by this date by logging into your ontariocolleges.ca account to [confirm your offer](#). (Applicants should check their offices of admission to confirm deadlines)
- **JUNE 1, 2025** – TUITION DEPOSITS DUE. The colleges require payment of a tuition deposit in June to secure your spot in your program. Each college sets its own tuition deposit amount and payment deadline. This information will be communicated to you by the college.

Fall 2025 Programs

Apply

Early October, 2024

The online application is available at ontariocolleges.ca.

February 1, 2025

The deadline for applying to highly competitive programs. Applications received and paid for before this date will be given equal consideration by the colleges.

NOTE: Applicants for all programs are encouraged to apply before this date, as website and call volumes are highest at this time.

Offer

November 1, 2024

Earliest date the colleges may release offers to applicants. Offers will continue to be issued until programs are filled or wait lists are established.

NOTE: Applicants who have not met admission requirements for a program may be notified at any time during the application process.

Accept

November 1, 2024

Earliest date that applicants may confirm an offer of admission.

May 1, 2025

The most common deadline for confirming offers of admission - but not the only one. Applicants should always review their offers of admission for exact deadline dates.

June 1, 2025

Earliest date that colleges may require payment of tuition fees.

Data Transmission Schedule

Data files from school boards and / or high schools are due on the following dates:

October 4, 2024

Target date for demographics, marks history, and current and projected registrations for the entire school year. OCAS requires marks history for all courses taken in grades 9, 10 and 11.

November 15, 2024

Deadline for demographics, marks history, and current and projected registrations for the entire school year. OCAS requires marks history for all courses taken in grades 9, 10 and 11.

Deadline for first semester midterm marks. Schools may transmit interim marks for full-year courses as soon as they are available.

February 14, 2025

Deadline for first semester final marks and currently enrolled second semester courses. For non-semestered schools: Interim marks are due.

April 25, 2025

Deadline for second semester midterm marks. For non-semestered schools: Interim marks are due.

July 4, 2025

Deadline for all final marks and proof of graduation, regardless of the scheduling model.

August 8, 2025

Deadline for all final marks and/or summer school final marks and proof of graduation.
