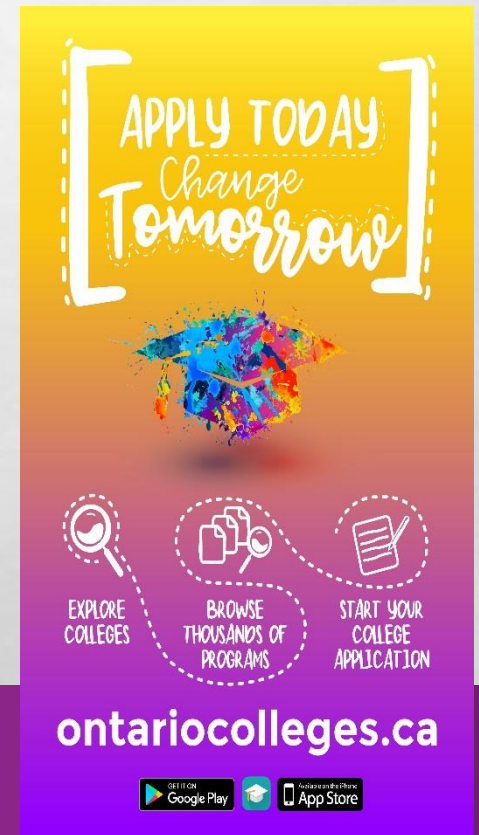

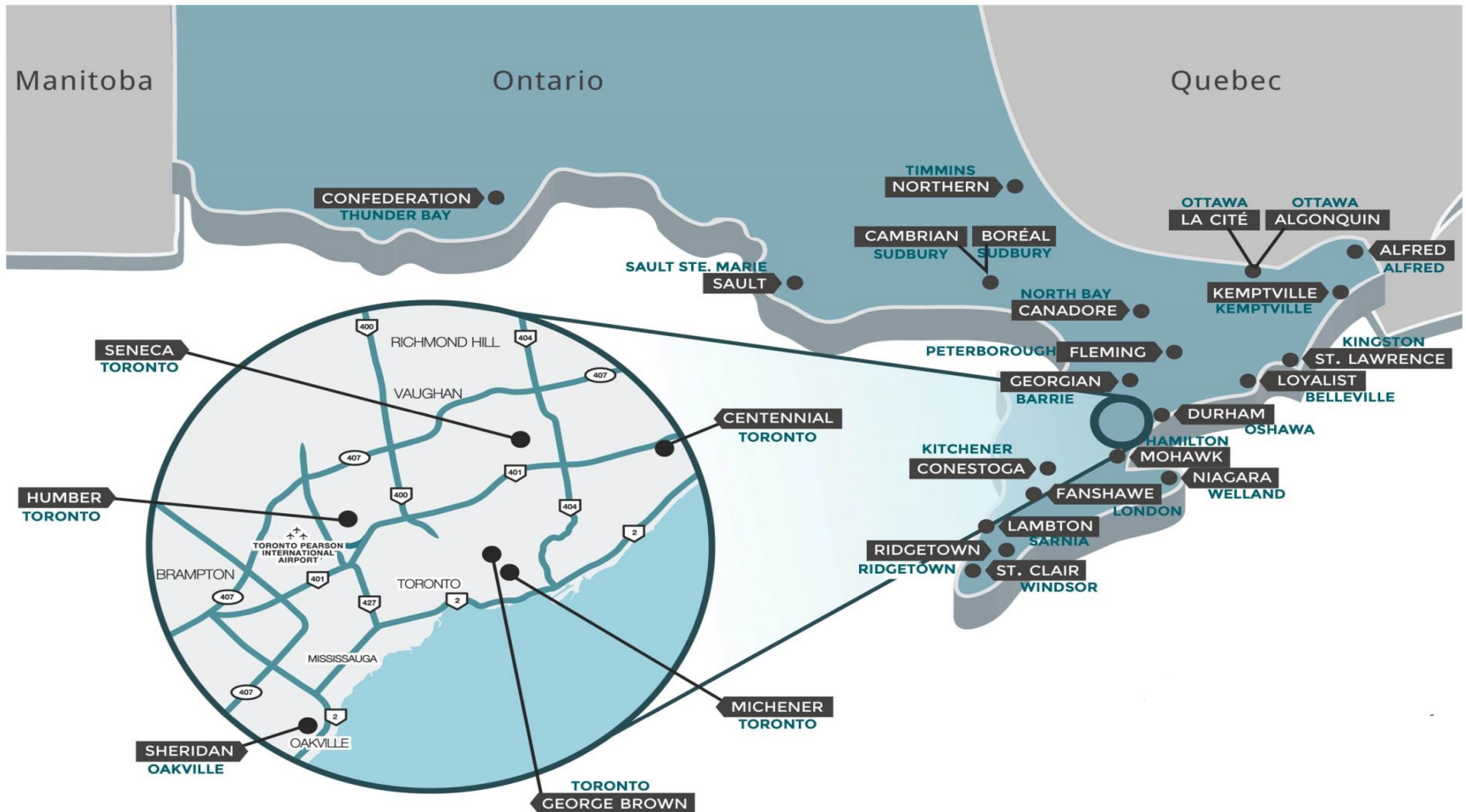

October 4th, 2020– *Online Application Opens*

- Start your 2020/21 application!
- Colleges may begin to notify applicants they've received their application.

November 20, 2020–*Mid-Term Marks sent to Colleges*

- Sem. 1 Mid-Term Mark Transmission to College

December 16, 2020 – *Full Disclosure (sem.1)*

- Last day to drop a course without it showing on your transcript BUT it should be done before Nov. 19th!

February 1, 2021 – *Application Deadline*

(highly competitive programs)

- Last day to apply to highly competitive programs
- Some Colleges begin to send offers to applicants

Spring 2021 – *Full Disclosure (Sem. 2)*

- You must drop a course prior to this day for it to show on your transcript

May 1, 2021 – *Deadline to confirm offers*

- Most common deadline for confirming offer of acceptance / admission
- Applicants should check their specific offices of admission to confirm deadlines.

June 15, 2021 – *Tuition Deposit Due*

- Earliest date payment of tuition fees is required

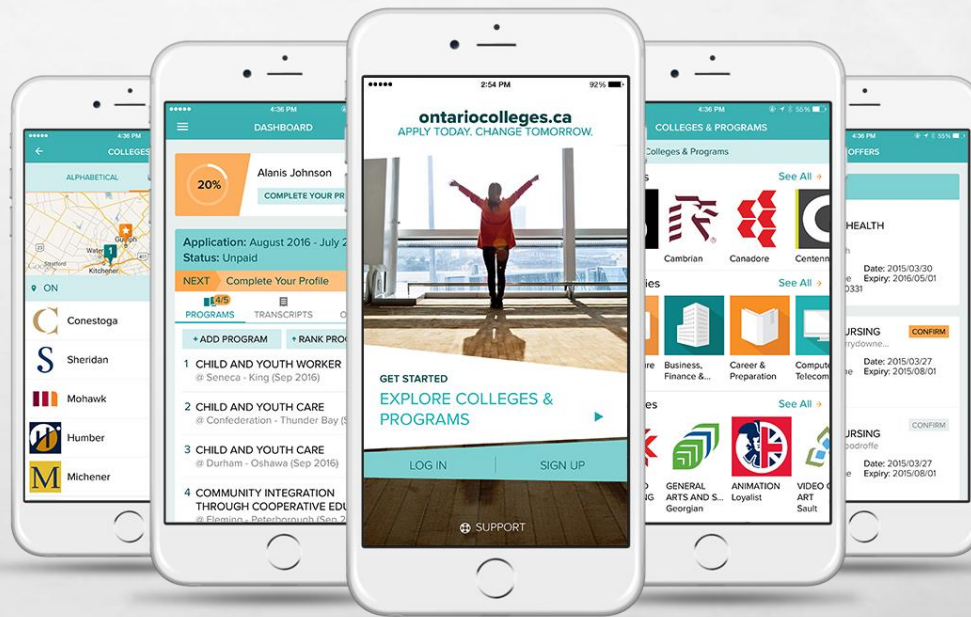

What is an Apprenticeship?

- Someone who learns a skilled trade on the job under the direction of a certified tradesperson.
- Apprentices also attend 'in-school' training for two or three sessions, alternating with work.



BENEFITS OF AN APPRENTICE?

- Earn money while you learn
- Hands on Experience with instruction and guidance from an expert in the field.
- Professors with extensive, current experience in industry state-of-the-art facilities
- You may qualify for income support while in school through Employment Insurance Canada benefits or training allowance

A post secondary option that combines on-the-job training with technical in-class training to become a highly skilled tradesperson
