Spring 2021 – Full Disclosure (Sem. 2)

You must drop a course prior to this day for it to show on your transcript

December 16, 2020 – Full Disclosure (sem.1)

Last day to drop a course without it showing on your transcript BUT it should be done before Nov. 19th!

May 1, 2021 - Deadline to confirm offers

- Most common deadline for confirming offer of acceptance / admission
- Applicants should check their specific offices of admission to confirm deadlines.

June 15, 2021 – Tuition Deposit Due

> Earliest date payment of tuition fees is required

What is an Apprenticeship?

- Someone who learns a skilled trade on the job under the direction of a certified tradesperson.
- Apprentices also attend 'in-school' training for two or three sessions, alternating with work.

WHAT IS OSAPP

THE ONTARIO STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (OSAP) IS A FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM THAT CAN HELP YOU PAY FOR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.

- > OSAP OFFERS FUNDING THROUGH:
 - > GRANTS: MONEY YOU DON'T HAVE TO PAY BACK
 - > A STUDENT LOAN: MONEY YOU NEED TO REPAY ONCE YOU'RE DONE SCHOOL
- WHEN YOU APPLY FOR OSAP, WE AUTOMATICALLY CONSIDER YOU FOR BOTH GRANTS AND LOANS. IF YOU DON'T WANT TO TAKE A LOAN, YOU CAN DECLINE IT AFTER YOUR APPLICATION IS APPROVED.

YOU MAY NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR OSAP IF YOU:

- HAVE ENOUGH FINANCIAL RESOURCES, INCLUDING OTHER FORMS OF GOVERNMENT AID, TO COVER YOUR EXPENSES ALLOWED BY OSAP
- REPORT INCOME ON YOUR OSAP APPLICATION THAT'S SIGNIFICANTLY DIFFERENT FROM WHAT YOU REPORTED TO THE CANADA REVENUE AGENCY (CRA)
- HAVE DEFAULTED ON A STUDENT LOAN
- HAVE GRANT OR BURSARY OVERPAYMENTS OR MULTIPLE OUTSTANDING LOAN FAILED OVER PAYMENTS
- A CREDIT CHECK
- DECLARED BANKRUPTCY OR CONSUMER PROPOSAL, OR CONSOLIDATION ORDERS
- HAVE REACHED YOUR LIFETIME LIMIT OF STUDENT LOAN FUNDING (340 WEEKS OF FUNDING, 400 WEEKS OF FUNDING FOR DOCTORAL STUDIES, 520 WEEKS OF FUNDING FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES)
