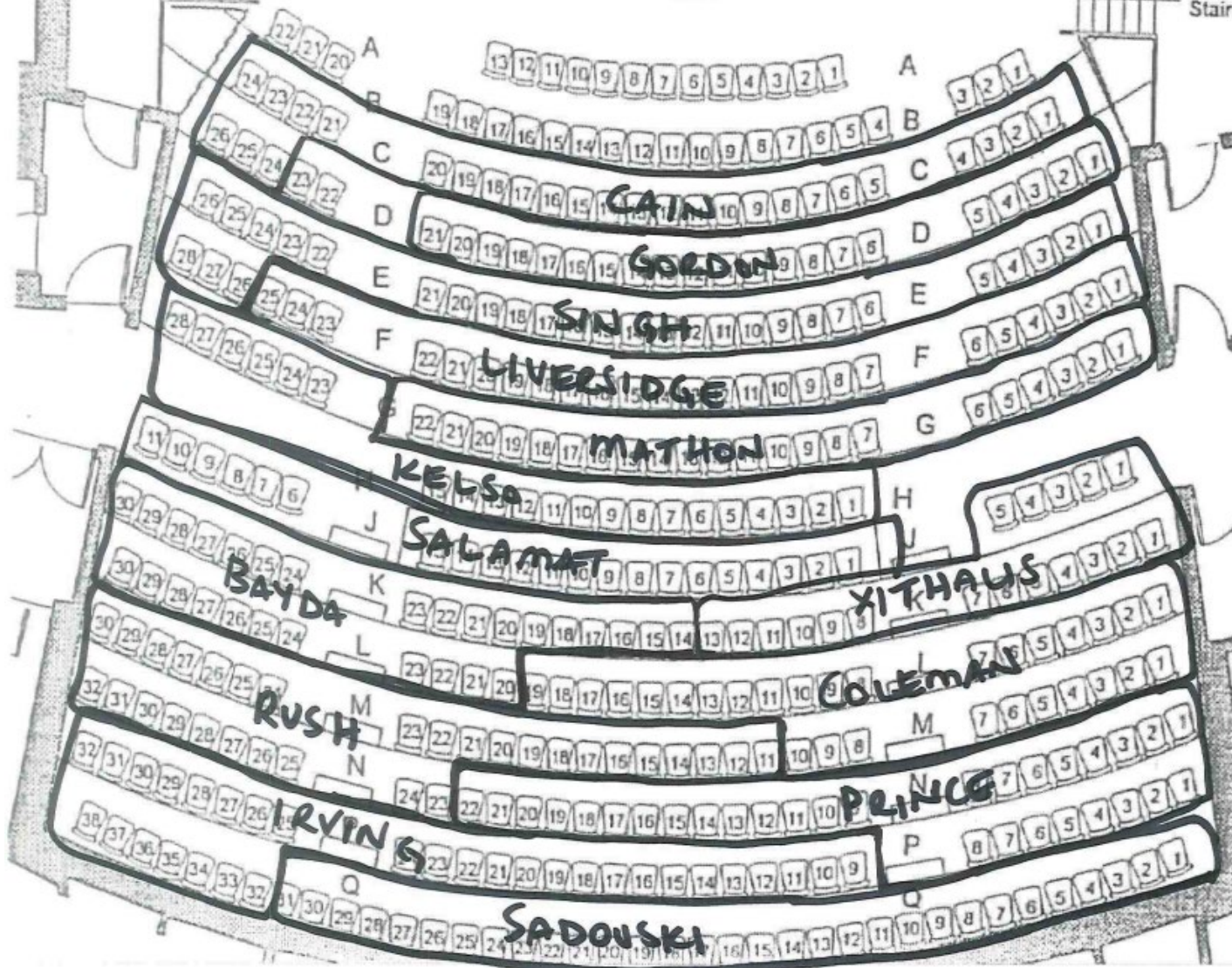

E.g. Nursing. You must meet the admission requirements for university before you can apply (6 Grade 12 U/M Courses) and **sometimes application through OUAC is required**.

Academic Requirements

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), or equivalent, or mature student status (19 years or older)
- Grade 12 English (C or U), or equivalent (minimum grade required), or take the **Centennial College English Skills Assessment for Admission**
- Grade 11 Mathematics (C, M, or U) or Grade 12 Mathematics (C, or U), or equivalent (minimum grade required), or take a **Centennial College Math Skills Assessment for Admission**

Additional Requirements

- **English language proficiency**

English Proficiency Requirements

- Colleges may require international students who have not completed their last 3 or 4 years (could vary by school) of full-time studies in English to provide a language proficiency test score.

Please refer to the specific college you are planning attending to see which test they accept and what scores they require (Eg. Duolingo, TOEFL, IELTS, etc.)

*These can be different at different schools

Admission Requirements:

Keep Your Eyes Peeled For Minimum Grade Requirements

(E.G. 65% IN ENG4C) and “HIGHLY COMPETITIVE PROGRAM” DESIGNATIONS

Select college programs to a maximum of **5** program choices with no more than 3 choices from one college .

The most commonly required courses for admission to college Diploma Programs are: Grade 12 English (ENG4C) Grade 12 Math (MAP4C)

Grade 11 or 12 Sciences (SBI3C, SCH4C, SPH4C)

*Admission requirements vary from college to college even if title of program is the same

*Students with U/M level courses will still meet C level admission requirements

Most college programs now have agreements in place with specific universities that allow transfer into specific university programs (Eg. 2 +2 Programs)

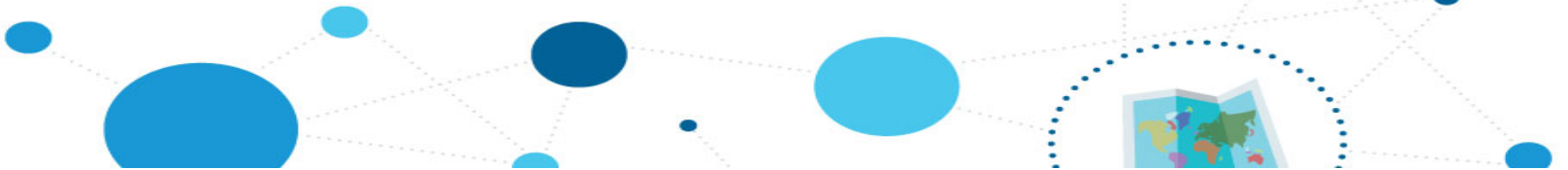

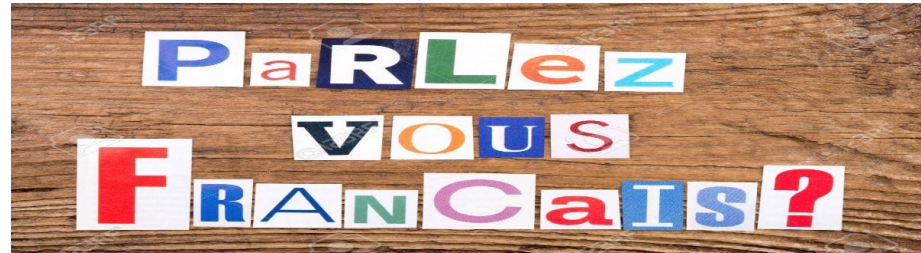

Paying for College: Tuition and Financial Assistance

Although college tuition costs are typically lower than university, there are variations from college to college and from program to program.

Average cost of tuition for **one academic year** in an Ontario college program:

- Diploma Programs - \$2,400
- Graduate Certificate Programs - \$3,600
- Bachelor's Degree Programs - \$6,100
- Collaborative Programs - \$5,000

You can also expect an average of \$800 in ancillary fees (student activity fees, athletic fees, health insurance, etc.) and \$1,300 for books and supplies.

Please note that these figures do not include living costs, such as rent, utilities and transportation.

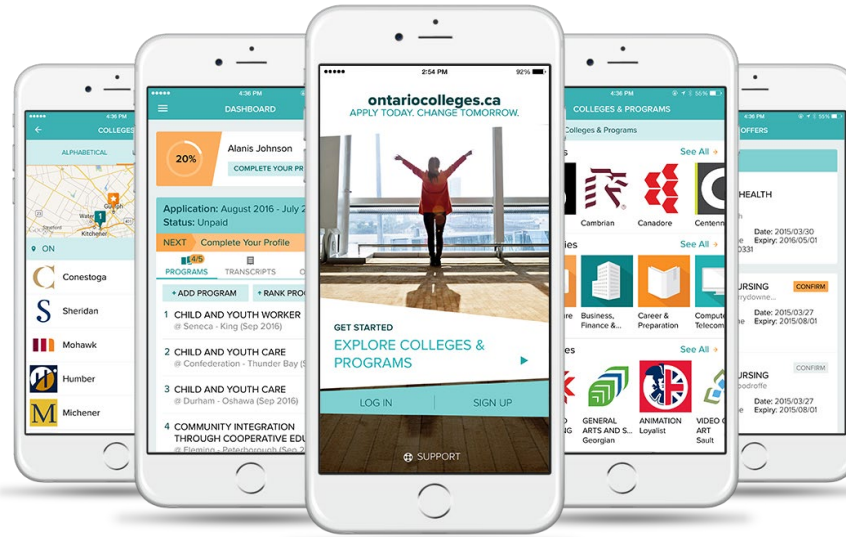

IMPORTANT DATES

- **EARLY OCTOBER**– ONLINE APPLICATION OPENS. Online college applications become available for programs beginning in the following academic year. You may create an account and [begin your application](#).
- **NOVEMBER 1, 2023**– EARLIEST OFFER DATE. Earliest date that colleges may begin to send offers of admission to programs for the upcoming academic year. Offers continue until programs are filled.
- **FEBRUARY 1, 2024**– EQUAL CONSIDERATION DATE. Apply on or before this date to receive equal consideration for admission to programs starting the following fall. After this date, colleges enter applications on a first come, first served basis until programs are full.

Note that applications to **Highly Competitive Programs** must be received by this date in order to be considered.
- **MAY 1, 2024** – DEADLINE TO CONFIRM OFFER OF ADMISSION. Must accept your offer by this date by logging into your ontariocolleges.ca account to [confirm your offer](#). (Applicants should check their offices of admission to confirm deadlines)
- **JUNE 2024** – TUITION DEPOSITS DUE. The colleges require payment of a tuition deposit in June to secure your spot in your program. Each college sets its own tuition deposit amount and payment deadline. This information will be communicated to you by the college.
