



NHS French Immersion Program Course Selection Planning Chart

Ten French Immersion credits are required for the French Immersion Certificate, including four FI French courses, one from each grade. Four of the FI program credits are prescribed and have been shaded in the chart below. A minimum of six additional FI credits must be earned from the non-prescribed FI program options to meet the FI certificate requirements.
