

## NHS French Immersion Program Course Selection Planning Chart

**Ten French Immersion credits are required for the French Immersion Certificate**, including four FI French courses, one from each grade. Four of the FI program credits are prescribed and have been shaded in the chart below. A minimum of six additional FI credits must be earned from the non-prescribed FI program options to meet the FI certificate requirements.
