

Newmarket High School Graduation Awards 2024

Nena Marsden Memorial Bursary

Each year, the Georgina Historical Society sponsors an essay competition for the Nena Marsden Memorial Bursary in the amount of \$500.00. All graduating students who reside in the Town of Georgina and who will be attending a post-secondary institution in the fall of 2023 are eligible. A Committee consisting of members of the Georgina Historical Society will review each submission to determine the student who will be the recipient of the Bursary.

The criteria are as follows:

- (a) Open to all graduating students residing in the Town of Georgina and entering post-secondary school in 2024
- (b) Format either:
 - (i) a 1000 to 1200 word essay or
 - (ii) a multimedia essay –Video or PowerPoint – 3 to 5 minutes in length which is Windows Compatible
- (c) Topic –**What is your favourite historical location in Georgina and explain why**
- (d) **Deadline – Friday May 31, 2024**

For the sole purpose of promoting Canada's proud heritage, please be advised that all submitted images, copy and communications to our bursary program/multimedia exhibit are subject to being distributed via all forms of traditional and new media. While no one will be financially compensated for submissions of this nature, we all benefit by letting everyone else know what we all know...that history is worth exploring and celebrating. It is the responsibility of the entrant to retain copyright permissions, where necessary.

- Each submission must have a title page with the title, student's name and school.
