Schools Remain Closed

This week, the provincial government announced that the current closure of all Ontario schools will be extended **until the end of the school year.** This is in an effort to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic. **All schools in York Region District School Board continue to be closed to students during this time.**

It is critically important at this time to continue to follow the direction of public health to practise social distancing in order to flatten the curve of this pandemic virus.

We do not yet know the plan for school in September. These details will be communicated to you as they become available.

ANTI-BLACK RACISM

We echo the <u>deep concern of our Director of Education</u> and the <u>YRDSB Chair</u>, and express our school's commitment to Anti-Black Racism.

Our educators are working to support students from a distance, both through intentional teaching, and support with mental health and well-being.
