- 4. **Student Leadership:** The Leadership team at Oscar Peterson consists of students in grades six to eight who have come together to work on four different initiatives within the school. When the team first came together they brainstormed what they believed to be areas of need within the school and where they could make a positive contribution. The four areas consist of:

**Recess Crew:** This group of students are working to distribute equipment during recess and will be joining efforts with the Healthy Schools Committee to create a recess program where older students model social skills and a variety of games to our younger students.

**Peer Mediators:** The students on this committee will be trained to help mediate student conflict on the yard. Their intent is to work with students on their development of conflict resolution strategies as well as provide another avenue for students to voice their concerns.

Jazz Assemblies: This committee is working to provide an opportunity for students to demonstrate their accomplishments at an assembly. During assemblies, students will see themselves reflected in a slideshow, share learning from their classroom, and allow teachers an opportunity to reflect upon the many accomplishments of the students at Oscar Peterson. 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**Spirit Days:** The Spirit Day Committee has brainstormed a variety of topics for monthly spirit days. They have thought hard about the topics chosen and ensured that they are something every student in the school would be able to participate in.

The Leadership team is a dedicated group of students who are committed to the achievement and well-being of all students. We look forward to seeing their success as they work on their various initiatives.

- 6. Robotics Champions: Oscar Peterson Public School's Robotics Team (Cyber Jazz) were the champions at the York Region FIRST Lego League (FLL) Regional Qualifying Tournament on Saturday, at St. Robert Catholic High School in Richmond Hill. Twenty-Four teams from York Region and surrounding areas were registered for the tournament. This was Oscar Peterson's third straight York Region championship and they have qualified for the Provincial Championships on January 18 at UOIT in Oshawa. Well done team!
- 7. Eco-Schools: Our Eco Club at Oscar Peterson has been working diligently on many new initiatives. We have started up a recycling program where each class must take care of their own recycling, which creates awareness. We have also started something called a "Boomerang Lunch." This means that all food waste, plastic wraps, wrappers, and drink boxes will be coming home. This is a fantastic way to bring awareness to both students and families about how much waste they are creating. To avoid too much waste coming home, try a reusable water bottle instead of sugary juice boxes, tupperware containers are an easy way to pack food, and try cutting up some fresh fruit and veggies instead of sending fruit snacks in a wrapper. Our Eco Monitors will soon be tallying up the waste from each classroom, and some exciting rewards are waiting for the class with the least amount of waste each month!
- 8. Equity and Inclusivity Committee: 'Inclusive education is based on the principles of acceptance and inclusion of all students.
