SUMMER SCHOOL

The York Region District School Board will once again be offering a Grade 6, 7 & 8 Summer School program. This 14 day program is designed to reinforce curriculum. Students must register in the program for their current school grade as this is not an acceleration program. For example, a grade 7 student would register for the grade 7 program as it reinforces grade 7 content.

The program will operate from July 2 to July 19, 2019 (8:45 am - 3:25 pm). Please note that Keswick H.S. times are 8:45 am - 3:33 pm. A typical day has Language and Numeracy instruction in the morning with Arts based programming in the afternoon. There are both lunch and recess breaks during the day. Students will need to bring a lunch, snacks and plenty to drink each day.

The following programs will be offered:

- Language and Math reinforcement for students who do not have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) or an English Language Learner (ELL) designation.
- Language and Math reinforcement for students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP).
- English Language Learner (ELL) Language for students who are ELL Stage 1 or 2 learners. The focus is on reading, writing and speaking.

International and Indigenous Languages (IIL) Program Registration for 2019-2020

Elementary International and Indigenous Languages Program Registration for the 2019-2020 school year will begin on Thursday, April 11, 2019. We are pleased to announce that we are now offering online registration for our elementary program. Registering online will eliminate wait times and long line-ups. To facilitate registration, on Thursday, April 11, 2019 at 4:00 pm, online registration will be available for the first time through Edsby on our webpage: www.yrdsb.ca/international-languages

Families can still register in person at the language site starting April 11 and in September. Please contact our office at international.languages@yrdsb.ca if you would like to register in person before September.

Did you know that the IIL Program has over 20 languages to choose from? Currently we have approximately 15,000 students registered in our programs across the Board. Students from SK to Grade 8 are eligible to take language classes that run once a week during weekday evenings (from Tuesday to Friday) or Saturday mornings for 2.5 hours. There are many new and exciting things in store for the upcoming 2019/2020 school year, such as the opportunity to learn the Indigenous languages Ojibwe and Cree.

Please note that due to space limitations, registration applications will take place on a first-come-first-serve basis. Classes may be cancelled due to low enrolment or lack of teacher availability.

BIKE SAFETY REMINDERS: YRP

A great number of kids ride their bike to school. Don't forget to teach them the dos and don'ts of safe cycling.

- By law, all riders under the age of 18 must wear a properly fitted, safety approved helmet
- Ride in the same direction as the traffic
- Dress brightly to be seen, especially in winter and fall when it is dark in the morning
- Children under 10 should not ride on the road
- Use a horn or a bell to let cars know you are there
- Always use the appropriate hand signals to let drivers know what you plan to do. The hand signals are: signalling left (left arm straight out), stop (left arm bent down) and right (left arm bent up). An alternative to right turn signalling is right arm straight out

INTERNATIONAL AND INDIGENOUS LANGUAGES

**ELEMENTARY PROGRAM
2019-2020**

This program provides any child with the opportunity to speak, read and write a new language or maintain heritage language and culture.

Duration

Classes operate once a week for 2.5 hours for 30 sessions from September to June.

Eligibility

Elementary school-age children, grades SK to 8. Students must be age 5 before December 31. Proof of age is required

Course Materials & Fees

Free program funded by the Ontario Ministry of Education. A \$20 non-refundable, consumable/resource fee is due at registration. Cheques must be made payable to the International and Indigenous Languages Program. Visa students are required to pay an additional \$200 for registration.

How to Register

Online Registration (NEW!)

NOTE: use of a laptop or desktop is highly recommended over a mobile device.

1. Use your existing Edsby parent account to [register online](#).
2. If you do not have an Edsby account, [create a new account](#) first, then register online. Please also see [our step-by-step registration instructions](#).
3. Please have your credit card (Visa/MasterCard) or PayPal account ready. If paying by credit card, you will see a transaction charge of \$20.00 called YRDSB LANG on your billing statement.
4. Select the language course, date, time and location.
5. You will be required to provide your child's OEN (Ontario Education Number) as part of the registration. This number is located on your child's report card. For students who are not current YRDSB day school students, this number is not required.

6. IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Please print the "Registration Submitted" page for your records.
- You will receive two email confirmations:
 - one from Edsby confirming the registration was submitted
 - one from PayPal with your payment details
- The description that will appear on your credit card statement for this charge will be 'YRDSB LANG'.

In-person Registration

Visit the school site offering the language class during class hours. Continuous, in-person registration is available until January 31. To register, please bring:

- Proof of age (students must be 5 years of age by December 31)
- Ontario Education Number (OEN) (found on the child's report card)
- \$20 by cheque, payable to International and Indigenous Languages Program or cash

Non-YRDSB students must also bring:

- Proof of status in Canada (Canadian citizens require one original Citizenship/Immigration document; other citizenships require two Citizenship/Immigration documents)
