Student voice is important to York Region District School Board. From November 12 to 30, 2018, the York Region District School Board will invite all students to participate in the Every Student Counts Survey (ESCS). The purpose of this census survey is to better understand YRDSB's diverse student population as well as students' experiences in school and outside of school. The survey results will be used to help improve our schools and to:

- Identify and eliminate systemic barriers to student success;
- Create more equitable and inclusive school environments; and,
- Improve student achievement and well-being.

All students will be given the opportunity to participate. Accessibility options will be available for any student who needs assistance completing the survey.

- For students in **Kindergarten to Grade 6**, the survey will be sent home to be completed with a parent/guardian.
- Students in **Grades 7-12** will be invited to complete the census at their school.

CCI Research has been contracted to work with the Board to conduct the survey and to ensure data privacy, security and adherence to all relevant legislation. 

We are pleased to provide you with the results of the 2017-2018 EQAO assessments of Reading, Writing and Mathematics for the primary (Grade 1-3) and junior divisions (grade 4-6). The table below indicates a comparison of province, York Region District School Board and our school results. The figures below represent the total percent of students who scored at achievement level 3 (provincial standard) and level 4 (beyond provincial standard for the 2017-2018 school year).
