to congregate. Please reiterate in on council social media. An added challenge for the teachers to use masks and, a face shield too. Please re-iterate in our school social media. Parents also wear masks. We don't foresee any changes in cohorts, no changes in recess, staggered entry, etc.

- <u>Model Change request</u> seem to be balanced right now. We'll find out from the board in the next day or two how many kids are moving. Families will know by Feb 17th and families who kids classes are affected will be notified later that week.
- Q will kids get any mask breaks? We'll have to play it by ear. Hard line at the beginning, then ease back as needed, in order to ensure we're reinforcing board guidelines. Potentially teachers can bring classes out later on, and spread out, for an opportunity to take off their masks. We recognize if kids need a break, and we'll be empathetic. I.e. Julie will be doing 2 mask breaks & go outside. When classes are not scheduled to be outside, then they go AFTER recess to give them a break and get outside time.
- Q What happens to learning in between the inclass start next week and the EVS model, which begins in March? Right now, no board directive, however many teachers are still using Google classroom, but no plans for asynchronous learning. We don't expect a major change, our last look was 14 kids.
- Q when kids join virtual EVS, how do they meld into the classroom? Teachers for in-class & virtual learning are 'supposed' to be on the same program, per board directive at the beginning of the school year. We hope, for the most part, teachers have been able to stick to it and kids can pick up roughly where they left off. Teachers can share information as well, on assessment.

Fundraising/events:

- On-line auction update No progress to report yet. We will be putting together a proposal to Admin, following school directives & COVID protocols.
- Flip Give First 3 weeks were great, lost momentum after the holidays. Currently at \$447. Hoping to get more traction soon, perhaps to promote for upcoming holidays and with the economy opening up again soon.
