Events – Nehal Naz & Jen Administrator's update & school news Recap of Class Reorganization: We were able to hire new teachers, so have • 1.93 staff, Full-time reading recovery teacher, LTO's. Equates to new grds. 3 & 4 class, from a split to straight classes. A new, disturbing TikTok challenge has been published, supposed to be a • monthly challenge. Sept – vandalize school bathrooms – soap dispensers ripped/thrown in toilets, paper towels in urinals - students making poor choices, Oct - smack a staff member, Nov - etc. Brought to our attention by Safe Schools at the board. Going to provide support as needed. Staff will talk more about - how to address in a positive way. Positive school climate, what appropriate environment, portray good students in our society – to be helpful and good citizens. Safe School assemblies will be done in next few days. Normally done in a face-to-face setting – done in live stream. Feedback KLP: Are you able to share any resources to parents

to support families? Yes – an email will be sent to our community.

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- "New" survival year, everyone is working very, very hard. It's difficult and challenging. Still in hybrid, one of the very few, students are integrated however, there is difficultly in fluidity. Teachers are trying to make sure that students are included and meeting educational expectations. We will try to do our best and support our students and staff. All staff have Google classrooms set up, if they're unable to be at school (due to isolation) – they can log on to hear the lesson.
- Documenting a negative COVID test can be done by Attestation form and/or an email confirming a negative test. <u>KLP</u>: Thanks for this – it is helpful.

## Other updates:

• Reintroduction of students from virtual school to in person - support for education, social and mental well-being.

**Naz:** Don't' want to single students out, we have known that students were feeling isolated & lonely. Resources were shared last year, not singled out if you were virtual, etc. Try to integrate as a class. Support for educators to staff, on Board website. Classroom teacher is still point of contact if concerns with your child.

**Jenn:** Last year we sent many resources which were provided to us. Working on building communities w/in classes, including community circles.

• Curriculum night

**Naz**: Yes, we'll do a virtual Curriculum night. Info for parents by this Friday. Teachers would send link to parents on virtual presentation. Was able to access another time, if you can't attend the timeframe.

• Picture Day

**Naz**: Have been told that we are not to share anything, photographer has been 'hold', but no info yet, as board has not released approval.

Lunch protocols – cohorting, timing (eating vs outside/recess), monitor programs (grades and scheduling)
 Jenn – allowed to cohort by grade (still not allowed to do that), grades 1-5 get 30

min, grades 6-8 get 30 min and they go outside every other day. Grades 6-8 go to basketball spots. We have 7 lunch assistants, but would like a few more. Q: Can lunch assistants bring their child w. them (younger child)? A: No.

• Picking up kids or dropping off lunches

Prefer no drop offs, but if so, try to call ahead and office staff will pick it up. We're finding lots of requests for water bottles, forks/knifes/masks at the office, so hoping to get class kits. Kids CAN OUT go for lunch this year (grade 7 & 8). Grade 6 can go for lunch – with permission, but the students are asked to stay off grounds until lunch is over. Working OK for now. Request that they don't bring outside food/drink back with them. Social distancing is bit tricky right

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now. Note: If students don't get out at lunch – most teachers get outside at some point during the day also.

• Supervision During Lunch

EA's & Lunch Assistants are also covering. Assistants are also covering. JK/SK – only grades that get 100% supervision, others are roaming/floating. 2 people roaming 6 portables. Kids get 10 more minutes from before COVID to eat.

- Lunch fundraising pizza/sub/Greek
  Board still hasn't approved outside food programs yet. Have been allowed company can deliver sealed containers to be handed out. Natasha (council) will continue to facilitate, but we require two people for on-site & after-hours support.
- Spirit Wear

**Naz**: Staff are really overwhelmed right now, they'd be happy or thrilled, if school council wanted to take this on. One staff member was asking if folks wanted sweater/jackets (but not for the whole population).

• X-Games Status

**Naz**: X-Movement (Aussie X) – still in status quo. They are still doing online options, but we're not keen on it. Will check for any new things, but most staff still prefer to wait due to benefit in-person. We paid 1<sup>st</sup> installment. 2<sup>nd</sup> installment will be paid by School Budget. Rebecca: Council funds were transferred back. They do have online code – Naz will look for it and re-share.

- Outdoor Classroom Gardens work project Sara Dart & Cheryl Warrener are interested. They will see what we can do this fall since it's OK to gather – following Provincial guidelines – maybe more to share by next meeting. Q: Could classes take a role? Try to put assistance in place where students/curriculum can work it in as well?
- Basketball net screw is still missing.
  Naz something was fixed, will look at it tmrw.
- Proposed future meeting dates? (Nov 8, Dec 13, Jan 10, Feb 7, Mar 7, Apr 4, May 9, June 13) Found that staff meetings and school council meetings are on same day 1<sup>st</sup> Monday, and a rush to going home. Council will propose new dates.
- Naz: YRDSB email regarding Asynchronous Day on Oct 15<sup>th</sup> discussed with staff today. Physically impossible to provide technology for all families for asynchronous learning. Teachers will have conversations in class, provide lessons and activities, then students are expected to complete homework.

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- Naz: Regarding Council funds, suggest staff put together a wish list, discuss, think about what they'll need/foresee in the next few years, as part of the long-term goals. We'll bring to you and come up with a plan.
- Kate: HUGE Thanks to Rebecca, Amanda & Nehal so grateful for all your help and support. Congrats to Exec to start this years' planning.
