<ul> <li><u>School Council Meeting Survey</u> – 75% of respondents preferred this timeframe, will maintain</li> <li><u>Fundraiser – Support Your Child's Education</u> <ol> <li>School generated funds request to council – Summary: Email came in on Monday, read on Tuesday – 1 time opportunity to use non-board school generated funds up to \$30k for the purchase of Chromebooks. Contacted Tech leads, Wed. morning meeting, assessed needs &amp; on wish list was more Chromebooks. Large amount of e-waste now out of date. School had approx \$12k + school council ~\$13k. 79 computers &amp; \$318+tax, about \$25k in total.</li> <li>School Generated Fundraiser, letter to families &amp; community to assist – tax receipt issued for &gt; \$20.00. No way of knowing how much is going into the account until end of month. At next meeting, will be able to share. Open for 2 weeks.</li> <li>Q – Grad Fund? We'll find the \$ if not enough is raised. As well for Outdoor Classroom. I.e. Yearbooks, Grad, etc. \$ for a balloon arch – paid by school for 2020/21 grads.</li> <li>Q – When will the school receive Chromebooks? Q – What is the longevity for Chromebooks? We know some were not able to be used after getting some back after virtual learning. A – We'd like to get 3-5 yrs. out of it. Some were unusable/damaged when getting back and we didn't get all back. We had to get loaner tech from other schools & the board, as we gave out all we had to the community. About 75% was returned and many missing chargers. Damage also occurs at the school. Approx. 20k across all board was outstanding to return.

Currently working with tech leads to see what else is required in inventory.

Q – Was a bit surprised based on this great request. But now understand better. A – Prior to COVID – I used to meet with the staff on wish list and share with council. For example, we just recently purchased soft 'nerf' balls for tarmac. The school needed it and it was purchased through the school budget. ~ \$800. As a leadership we normally discuss & prioritize. Kate - Normally year-toyear we do spend our \$ in entirely each year. It was only when we came across COVID, we haven't been able to spend y-to-y.

Q – How much are you paying for Chromebook? A -\$318 – warranty & support.

- <u>Curriculum Night Overview</u> approximately 44

  1 person asked a question. Handful provided
  suggestions for improvement. Other feedback included

- <u>Renewed Computer Technology</u> initiative Not-forprofit org that provides tech for schools/families. \$60-300 would request to pay for desktop \$200-300 for laptops, Both would come w. MS Office. Application process online – limitations based on family income. If they know of a family that can't afford it, please let Naz know – she'll look into a subsidy.
- <u>Extracurricular Activities</u> x-country, volleyball etc. A few things being offered. Try not to put pressure of our staff hybrid is taken a huge toll on teachers. Many limitations related to board requirements, restrictions on space related to H & S. Also, hybrid is taking up significant amount of time to support those students. Priority is academics, social/emotional well-being for our students. Some x-country at the beginning of the school year for intermediate, limited practices due to cohorting, did their own school meet.
- Grade 8's have started planning <u>Grad</u> with Mr. Izzo.
- <u>Announcements Plan</u> for grade 8's doing 2 weeks at a time.
- <u>Dressing for the weather</u> student preparedness If it's cold dress warm. Rain boots for rain. Consider sending extra pair of socks.
- <u>Running Holiday Heros</u> this year. Unwrapped toy hats/mitt tree. More info to come.
- Q Re: Hybrid any idea when it will end? A At this time, we only know for this year. Board mandated a virtual year, but also provided funding last year, but took away funding this year. May not be the best approach for learning.
- Q Re: Full Online class. In some areas of the board, they have done that. Some teachers in our schools have no remote students. Our teachers have tried working through it together. Board has been provided directive teachers, should expect to use Hybrid if they have to.
