## Lockdown / Hold and Secure Procedures

Once again school staff and students will participate in YRDSB 'Lockdown' and 'Hold and Secure' drills intended to practice school responses to emergency situations. The purpose of the 'Lockdown' response is to minimize risk to students and staff to the presence of an armed or dangerous intruder or other similar violent threat within the school. The purpose of the 'Hold and Secure' response is to have students stay inside the school, lock all exterior doors, and resume business as usual in our school. The 'Hold and Secure' response would be used if an armed or dangerous intruder was in our neighbourhood. We will practice our first Lock Down drill during this coming Safety Week (week of Sept. 26).

#### Triple P Tip of the Month - Coping with Stress

Being a parent is busy and demanding and it's normal to feel stressed at times. However, if parents have a high level of stress, it can be hard for them to deal with their children's behavior calmly and may be less likely to spend time with them. Children are likely to grow up happy and learn what's expected of them when parents are consistently calm.

#### KEY STEPS:

- Think about helpful changes you can make to your lifestyle
- Try to notice tension early
- Find a relaxation technique that suits you and use it when you feel tense
- Think of coping statements to say to yourself when stressful situations arise
- Make sure you believe what you are saying to yourself
- Catch and challenge any unhelpful thoughts that increase your stress and replace them with more realistic or helpful ways of thinking about the situation
