
3rd: Ms. McAlear's 7/8s

Triple P Tip of the Month ~ Fears

Fears are common in childhood and a normal part of growing up.

Most of children's fears are mild, however some children have
fears that are so strong it stops them from doing things. Children
can learn to cope with fears with help from parents.

KEY STEPS:

- Talk with your child and tell them how you cope with your own fears
- Try not to show fearful reactions
- Teach your child coping strategies
- Help your child to gradually face their fears
- Remain calm when your child is scared or anxious
- Praise your child for facing their fears
- Encourage your child to try new things and do not let them avoid things they must do
