## Tentative School Organization for September 2018

We are projecting an enrolment of approximately 570 students. Here is the tentative class organization structure with 24 classes for 2018-2019:

### **French Immersion Primary Division Classes:**

Grade 1 (5 Classes); Grade 2 (4 Classes); Grade 2/3 (1 Class); Grade 3 (3 Classes)

### **French Immersion Junior Division Classes:**

Grade 4 (2 Classes); Grade 4/5 (1 Class); Grade 5 (1 Class); Grade 5/6 (1 Class); Grade 6 (2 Classes)

### **French Immersion Intermediate Division Class:**

Grade 7 (1 Class); Grade 7/8 (2 Classes); Grade 8 (1 Class)

This organization of classes is tentative and should our enrolment change over the summer, a re-organization will occur.

Congratulations to the Poplar Bank community as we have been awarded **Platinum status by Ontario Eco-Schools** for all our efforts to help the environment this year.

## Transportation Reminder

Please be reminded that your son/daughter's school bus transportation eligibility can change throughout his/her school career. Because walking distance requirements change in Grade 4 and your son/daughter will be attending Grade 4 next year, we encourage you to review his/her eligibility.

Busing in the York Region District School Board is provided in collaboration with the York Catholic District School Board and is governed by Board Policy #680 Student Transportation (full policy on the Board website at [www.yrdsb.edu.on.ca](http://www.yrdsb.edu.on.ca)). Below are the general provisions of eligibility identified in the Student Transportation Policy:

- ◆ All YRDSB students in Grades JK-3 who live within 1.2 km of their school are not eligible for transportation
- ◆ All YRDSB students in Grades 4-8 who live within 1.6 km of their school are not eligible for transportation
- ◆ All YRDSB students in Grades 9-12 who live within a transit served area are not eligible for transportation.

The distance is measured from the end of any driveway, via the shortest distance to the closest access point of the school property. Measurements are conducted using GIS software and confirmed via aerial photos. 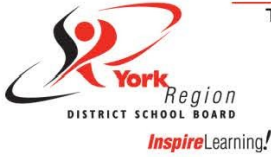

**INTERNATIONAL AND INDIGENOUS LANGUAGES PROGRAM**

**ELEMENTARY PROGRAM 2018-2019**

**This program provides any child with the opportunity to read, write and speak a new language or maintain heritage language and culture.**

**REGISTRATION:** Register in person at the language location see times listed below. (Please do not contact day schools for registration assistance). Continuous registration is available at the language site during regular class hours until January 31, 2019. To register parents must bring their child's OEN & YRDSB student number (if YRDSB student). The OEN number can be found on the day school report card. All non-YRDSB students must provide Proof of Status in Canada (Canadian citizens require one original Citizenship/Immigration document; Other Citizenship requires two) and complete a Pupil Eligibility Attestation Form.

**DURATION:** Classes operate once a week for 2.5 hours for 30 sessions from September to June.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Elementary school-age children, grades SK to 8 Students must be age 5 before December 31, 2018. Proof of age required.

**FEE:** Free program funded by the Ontario Ministry of Education. A \$20 non-refundable, consumable/resource fee is due at registration. Cheques must be made payable to the International Languages Program. Visa students are required to pay an additional \$200 for registration.
