

HAS YOUR CHILD'S VISION BEEN CHECKED? DETECT AND CORRECT VISION PROBLEMS EARLY!

Did you know 80 per cent of a child's learning during their first 12 years is visually based? Children will rarely complain about problems with their vision, but if left untreated, vision issues can lead to problems in school and at play.

Comprehensive eye exams with an optometrist are the only way to tell if your child's eyes are developing properly. If you have a child who was born in 2017 or 2018 and in junior or senior kindergarten, they may be eligible to receive one pair of FREE eyeglasses through the Eye See... Eye Learn Program. 
