1. Welcome

2. Active School Travel Program

Reena Mistry from YRDSB delivered a presentation with updates on the project achievements and future plans.

- This is \$100,000 government-funded project.
- The project was featured in the fall issue of Markham Life magazine.
- Randall PS is one of the 9 schools participating in the pilot project.
- Parents are encouraged to step up and support as ambassadors too.

Student ambassadors of ASTP from Randall PS also delivered a presentation on the importance of walking/cycling or riding a bus to school and explained how these activities help the students, parents, and environment. Students ambassadors have launched information posters and announcements promoting Winter Walk Day February 5th. Student ambassadors will continue to collect data.

3. Vaping

Mr. David Williams delivered a presentation on the harmful effects of vaping. Information handouts were distributed. Parents were encouraged to watch the resource video: https://youtu.be/uXzLt8roFWs

At the end of the presentation, there was an open discussion on vaping, what parents need to do and how to educate children on the harmfulness of vaping.

4. Staff Wish List

The teachers at Randall PS have requested parent's council to raise funds for recess bag sports/activity equipment including light-weight balls, skipping ropes etc. Students will use this equipment during recess time when they are confined to using only the paved areas around the school due to snow or rain puddles in the grassy areas.
