Our Kindergarten Educator Teams

- a Classroom Teacher
- a Prep-Coverage (planning time) Teacher



Entering our Learning Spaces

The Kindergarten Program includes learning in the **outdoors** as part of the instructional day.



Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather and for outdoor play.

Recess Time



Children have the opportunity to go outside for recess each day.

Morning Recess: 10:50 to 11:10 a.m.

Lunch recess: 1:10 to 1:50 p.m.

Lunch & Snack



In Kindergarten, many children make choices about going to the snack table when they are hungry. Educators support children as they begin to do this independently.

Lunch & Snack Tips

Your child will need lunch and snacks that:

- are in containers easy for your child to open and eat independently (please label containers)
- do not require heating
- do not contain nuts or nut products
- are litterless

Preparing lunches and snacks with your child the night before can make getting ready for school easier the next day.

Lunch and Snack Containers and Drinks



Please make sure all containers, lunch bags and water bottles are permanently labelled as many children have similar items.

- Slices of Apple, Orange, Clementine, Pear, Pineapple, Melon, Banana

- Yogurt (practice opening)
- Carrots, Celery, Zucchini Sticks
- Broccoli, Cauliflower pieces

- Apple or Fruit sauce (practice opening)
- Oatmeal Cookie, Arrowroot Cookies
- Muffins
- Favourite Healthy Cereal

- Pasta with favourite sauce & Veggies
- Mac and Cheese & Veggies
- Dumplings or Perogies with favourite sauce & Veggies
- Chicken and Rice/Potatoes & Veggies
- Chicken/Fish Sticks & Veggies
- Chicken/ Beef Stew & Veggies
- Vegan protein options & Veggies
- Pizza with favourite toppings
- Omelet with favourite toppings

Washroom and Self-Help Routines



Children are encouraged to:

- use the washroom with minimal assistance.
- wash their hands with soap and water.
- dress and undress themselves (zippers, buttons, shoes, etc.) as independently as possible.
- if unable to tie shoes 'No Tie' laces can be substituted.





Health and Wellbeing

We understand that at times it can be difficult to coordinate care for your child if they present an illness in the morning or late at night. However, sending a child to school when they are unwell puts the child at further risk of illness, as well as placing the other children and educators at risk of becoming ill as well.



When your child is sick:

- ★ Please keep your child at home
- ★ Please notify the school of the reason they will be away

If your child comes to school and teachers see that they are ill or they become ill during the day:

★ We will notify you immediately and request that you come and pick up your child.

Will Your Child be Taking the Bus?

In the morning, when the bus arrives at the school, all Kindergarten students are escorted to the Kindergarten yard and then they enter their classrooms via the exit doors.

In the afternoon, bus students line up inside the school and are escorted to their bus when it arrives.

Note: Should there be an inclement weather day, buses will be cancelled in the morning.

Backpack



- ★ two large sections
 ★ an outside pocket for a water bottle
- ★ large enough to fit an x-large ziploc, pocket folder, Library book, etc.
- ★ clearly labelled with your child's name

What goes inside the Backpack



- ★ a complete change of clothes in a labelled ziploc bag
- ★ lunch and snack bag (labelled)
- \star communication bag every day
- clearly labelled water bottle (outside pocket)
- ★ clearly labelled indoor running shoes (to stay at school)

Walking to school is encouraged. If your child arrives by car, please use the Designated Kindergarten drop-off zone.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time and is picked up on time.

The first day of school is a big event in the life of a family, so it's important to make it a positive one!





Arrive at the Kindergarten Drop-off area at 1:50 p.m. (Year 1 students)

Please note: regular school drop-off time will be 8:55 a.m.

Teachers will meet you at the gate and accompany your child into the classroom


Pick-up time is at 3:30 pm

Please be so kind as to remain outside the gated area.



Supported Entry

Drop off at the Kindergarten pen gate. Say a quick good-bye and then leave once a staff member has taken your child. Be confident and smile so your child knows they are okay. Tell the staff member who will be picking up your child for the first day and from then on.



Items to bring on the first day:

- backpack
- ziploc bag with a change of clothes
- pair of "indoor shoes"

*Note: Please mark all items clearly with your child's name



If you have to visit the school office, you are asked to park off school property as the parking lot is used by school staff.





Please don't park in the Drop-off Zones or the Bus Zone.

Safe School entry

All the doors will be locked at the start of the school day and the only access is via the front doors.

Press the "Call" button to access the building.



Safe School entry

All visitors must report to the front office.

No visitors may visit a classroom without permission from the office.

Please send a note, via your child's teacher, if you'll be picking them up early or signing them out for an appointment to minimize disruptions of other students' learning.



Please sign your child in or out of the school using the binder on the office front desk.

Safe School entry

Late arrival

If your child will be arriving at school late, please call the office and leave a message.

If you arrive and there are no staff in the Kindergarten yard, do not drop your child of in the yard. Simply walk them to the office and sign them in.



Please sign your child in using the "lates" binder on the office front desk.

Tips for the First Day of Kindergarten

- 1. get up on time to allow for a relaxed morning routine including a healthy breakfast
- 2. send a family photo in your child's backpack that they can visit throughout the day if they need to feel connected to you
- 3. remind your child of who is picking them up
- 4. use a goodbye routine you have practiced with your child
- 5. remember to remain cheerful and reassure your child that they will be okay!
