Please remember, the fewer calls we have to make, the sooner we are able to contact parents with a concern. When illness is at a peak we may have to make 50 or more calls in one morning.

Cross country Team practices begin September 9 and will meet every Tuesday and Thursday for the month of September for students in Grades 4 to 8.




#### **Textbooks**
