Rehearsals and planning are currently underway</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - September 26 is Curriculum night, featuring food trucks, pumpkin patch orders and water bottle sales - The Pumpkin Patch event will take place October 23 at Regency - A series of special lunches have been organized throughout the year, beginning with a Nacho Salad day on September 27 - Efforts will be made to boost online sales (vs cheques/cash) for all initiatives - EQAO results will be available effective September 25, 2019.
