Leader of the Day (LOD) Sharing

At the beginning of January, we are continuing to have each student share his/her favourite book with the class. It would be helpful if you could practice how to share this item by talking with your child about the 5 Ws.(<u>Who?</u> - Who gave you this book? <u>What?</u> What is your favourite part? <u>Where?</u> Where did it come from? (e.g., I borrowed it from the library., My parents bought it at the store., We cannot remember where we bought it from., etc.) <u>When?</u> - When did you get it? (e.g., It was a long time ago., I think I got it for my birthday., My Dad bought it for me last week when we went shopping., etc.) <u>Why?</u> - Why do you like it? (e.g., I like this book because it has very colourful pictures., I like it because I like learning about animals., The book has lots of rhyming words. I like stories about dogs., etc.)

The next round of sharing will <u>start with Rosalyn on January 12</u>. We are asking students to please share a favourite winter activity they like to engage in, either independently or with their family. For example, this could include skating, skiing, building a snowman or snowfort or going for a winter walk. We will send home a planning sheet to be completed and brought in as an oral language guide during your child's sharing time. It will focus on the 5 W's.
