8. EQAO	<p>Results for 2015/16 year discussion.</p> <p><b><u>Math Grade 9</u></b></p> <p>Academic we had 96% rating with level 3 and 4 level, with a board level of 90% and province 83%.</p> <p>Applied we had a 56% rating with level 3 and 4, with a board level of 55% and province 45% .</p> <p>For applied, note that the number of students are very small so % changes significant when a couple of students are not at level 3 or 4. Still we need to look at what we need to do. We will be focusing on level 2 students to move to level 3.</p> <p>Also note that information from EQAO is used to follow-up with students in Grade 10 and also do an analysis of areas that we can improve on the delivery of grade 9 math for future.</p> <p><b><u>Literacy Grade 10</u></b></p> <p>RHHS has a high % of students who are eligible to write the test and continues to outperform the Board and Province in first time eligible students who are successful on the OSSLT.</p> <p>Results are 94% success with 90% for the board and 81% for the province.</p> <p>EQAO Results can be found in the School Web site. A <a href="#">link</a> here as well.</p>	
9. Treasurer Report	<p>Two sources of Income:</p> <p>\$2x500 from School Board. Approved but money not received yet.</p> <p>\$1000 Pro Grant. We have been permitted by the Ministry. There were no expenditures as of today. Money is available.</p>
