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- Admin Report – Debbie Linkewich
 - Staffing: 5 additional sections , more gr 10 and gr 9 math. Hiring. Some student timetables may get rearranged – minimal movement
 - Building updates:
 - Carpeting removed from all areas, deep cleaning, storage areas, new uprights on field
 - Planning for new seating in hallway, fence improvement, outdoor space for students for lunch, improve accessibility
 - Art murals in foyers – in collaboration with an indigenous artist
 - School archive
 - New school programs
 - Gr 9 DE streamed English, gr 11 construction, gr 12 Phys ed leadership, Dance, Vocal repertoire. 65 students in choir
 - Cafeteria service to resume – look out for opening date in the weekly bulletin
 - New vendor was hired last yr and unfortunately the vendor didn't fulfill terms of contract and they got fired, so we didn't end up having a cafeteria
 - Cafeteria is not subsidised – breakfast program everyday

- Grad requirements
 - Grade 9 is the lightest homework requirements and students should try their best to finish their volunteer hours in gr 9
- Assessment and Evaluation Policy / Exams
 - Parents can opt out Any student from doing 2 mandatory online courses
 - 70% term work, 30% summative task like exam, or culminating project
 - Exams: not all courses will have an exam – summatives and exams are all in the final 2 weeks of the term
 - Exams are in a 5 day period Jan 25th-31s, June 19th-25th
