Orange Shirt Day – Every Child Matters: The Orange Shirt Day movement started in 2013 to highlight the pain and suffering of thousands of Indigenous children who were sent to residential school throughout the last century. The colour of the shirt is connected to the experience of Phyllis Webstad who was sent to Cariboo Residential School near Williams Lake, BC, in 1973. The shirt has since gone on to become a symbol of a national movement that recognizes the suffering of Indigenous children at residential schools across the country and to show a renewed commitment to ensure that every child matters. Recognize the resiliency and bravery of Residential School Survivors by wearing an orange shirt.

Arts Program: We are excited to share information regarding the RHPS Arts program that acts as an enrichment to the curriculum for all students. Each grade will have the opportunity to see or participate in 7 different workshops or performances. Please see the linked letter for more information.
