# NO PEANUTS OR NUT PRODUCTS

#### **Peanut and Nut Aware**

In our school, there are students and staff with potentially life-threatening forms of allergic reactions called Anaphylaxis. If by accident, the allergic child is to come into contact with even a small quantity of peanut or nut products, their residues, or even the scent of nuts, the child may develop hives, swelling and demonstrate difficulty in breathing. If the reaction is not stopped, the symptoms may become more severe leading to a drop in blood pressure, unconsciousness and or death. Immediate action must be taken by use of adrenaline injection (Epipen). All affected individuals in our school with this condition carry an Epi-pen at all times and staff are trained in their use and administration.



#### **Scent Sensitive**

Please be aware that we have both students and staff who are allergic to the smell of strong perfumes, after shaves and deodorants. The strong scents in these items can trigger allergic reactions including stuffy nose, watery eyes and/or migraine headaches. Please avoid wearing strong scents to school.

#### Medication

Either on a regular basis or at times throughout the year, some students may need to take medication at school. Parents must complete a permission form and have it approved by the Principal before medication can be taken or stored in the school. All medication is kept locked, in the office and students are supervised as they take any medication. Students are not permitted at any time to take any medication to school and keep it in their classroom, lunch bags, backpacks or lockers.



#### **Transportation Information**

In order to ensure the safety of all students who ride the bus to and from school please notify your child's teacher and/or the office if your child is eligible for bussing, but will NOT be riding the bus. It is very important that we know how your children will be going home at the end of the school day.

# **Keeping Our Schools Safe and Orderly**

In accordance with the principal's responsibilities under the Education Act to ensure a safe and orderly learning environment, the school has the right to search school property, such as lockers and desks, without notice to or permission of any person. 
Also, in the staffroom will be a bake sale with lots of yummy treats. Proceeds will go towards buying technology for the classrooms.




# Safe Welcome Program!

Thank you for your ongoing feedback regarding the Safe Welcome Program in our school. As a result of this feedback, and working in cooperation with Plant Services staff, the procedure is being adjusted to allow more effective access to schools. These changes are:

- SAFE SECURE SCHOOLS
- ✓ The school front door is to be **unlocked** between the time of the dismissal bell (2:45 p.m.) and when the main office closes (3:30 p.m.).
- √ The childcare door and staff will provide access once the front door is locked after the main
  office closes.
- ✓ Any classroom door to a childcare program or an after school activity <u>must</u> be locked when these programs are in session and an external door is unlocked.
- √ The front door is to be unlocked 15 minutes before a permit begins, and is to be locked 15 minutes after the permit ends.
