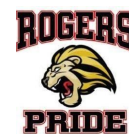

Passover: or Pesach, is the eight-day Jewish Festival that commemorates the emancipation of the Israelites from slavery in ancient Egypt. Passover observances include avoiding leaven and are highlighted by the Seder meals that include wine, matzah and bitter herbs. Passover begins at sundown on the first day and ends at nightfall on the eighth day. Passover is celebrated by many Jews because it is a family holiday. The Seder is a feast that includes the learning of the Passover story.

Easter: Good Friday is the Friday preceding Easter Sunday. For Christians, Easter is the most joyful celebration of the church year. Christians all over the world honour the resurrection of Jesus from the dead on Easter Sunday. Western rite Christians observe Easter on the first Sunday after the first full moon that falls on or after March 21. Eastern Orthodox Christians celebrate it on the first Sunday after both the Spring Equinox and Jewish Passover. Once every few years the days coincide.
