You will receive an email from your child's teacher with information about how to join the virtual event. A stable internet connection is needed to join.

Once you join the meeting, please follow the meeting guidelines below:

- Please turn your camera off

Please be aware that during the Virtual Curriculum/Meet-the-Teacher Night you must refrain from:

- recording any aspect of a Google Meet (including pictures, voices or video) using internal or external recording devices;
- taking photos or screenshots of anything other than when given explicit permission or direction by the teacher to do so (e.g. a visual used for instructional purposes that won't be reposted later).
- distributing/posting any recorded, copied or distributed materials in any way, including to all social media platforms; and
- editing or manipulating materials in any way.

COVID-19 school screening tool

Check your child for symptoms daily


When to stay home

- Anyone feeling unwell or showing symptoms of COVID-19 must stay home / not enter school
- Any students and their families must stay home / not enter school if they:
 - · Have had close contact with a confirmed case
 - Have had close contact with someone who is showing symptoms of COVID-19 who travelled outside of Canada 14 days prior to symptom onset
 - Have had close contact with someone who lived in or worked in a facility known to be experiencing an outbreak of COVID-19 (long-term care home, prison)
 - Have recently travelled outside Canada; regardless if they have symptoms or a negative test result, they are still required to quarantine for 14 days and cannot enter school during that time
