### First Day of School Routine

When students arrive at school on their first day, they should already know who their teachers are and the room number.

Our teachers will be standing outside at the back of the school with a sign to indicate their name and class. Students will line up, following physical distancing guidelines and will be led in by their teachers. Students in Grade 4-8 should be wearing their masks at this time.

Kindergarten students will be met by the teacher, DECE and an EA for each class in the Kindergarten play area. Parents are asked to remain outside of the play area and leave the school promptly once your child has been received safely.

# **Inclement Weather First day plans:**

In case of inclement weather (rain), staff will be at each of the two entrances at the back of the school to direct students to their meeting spots.

<u>Gr 1, 2, 3 and 4 -</u> Enter through Door B (East side of the tarmac), meet in the gym (lined up in front of their teacher, physically distanced) and be taken to their classrooms

**Gr. 5-8** Enter through Door A (closest to the field) and will go directly to their homeroom classes where they will be directed by their teachers and other support staff.

<u>Kindergarten</u> - DECE, Teacher and Educational Assistants will receive the students at the Kindergarten Play Area and support them to enter their classrooms directly



# Return to School Reminders (please see Reopening Plan on YRDSB website for more details:

#### Link)

Parents/guardians are to provide their child(ren) with 3 personal face coverings (a mask) to bring with them to school daily. This is a requirement to help to reduce the spread of respiratory droplets and to protect others.

- •In Grades 4 to 8, students will wear cloth masks or disposable masks while in school.
- •In Kindergarten to Grade 3 cloth masks are strongly encouraged for students.
- •If a student does not have a face covering, they will be provided a non-medical mask by the office.
- Any student experiencing COVID-19 symptoms is required to remain home (the use of a mask in this situation is not an acceptable alternative).
- Once our students enter the school, it is highly recommended they remain at school until the end of the school day. Exceptions will be granted for medical/family appointments supported by *Ms. Durrani*.
- Please ensure your child brings their lunch and snacks required for their day at school. Lunch drop-offs will not be available, including access to lunch delivery services. (No pizza lunch service this year)
- Until further notice, visitor(s) are not to enter the school during hours of operation, unless identified through a prearranged exception. When a parent/guardian needs to meet with the Principal in person, the meeting must be scheduled in advance and Health and Safety protocol will be adhered to.

# Student Pickup During School Hours

- o Parents/guardians need to pre-arrange pickup with the office.
- o Office staff will record outgoing students in the 'Sign-In/Out' binder.
- Parents/guardians must ring the front door buzzer when they arrive at school and a staff member will come to the door to meet them.
- Parents/guardians are not to enter the building. Please ensure you have self-screened before coming to the school.

## **Technology:**

If you have not already done so, please call the school to arrange a 5-minute appointment to return borrowed technology (Chromebook and charger). If you're not available **tomorrow**, please book a time for **Thursday or Friday** to bring it back. We need to clean and restore the tech before redistributing it to our students. This year, we have new health and safety measures in place to help keep students and staff safe from the spread of COVID-19. Everyone, including families, plays a critical role in supporting health and safety in our school communities.

# Every day, please Screen your child for symptoms of COVID-19 and keep them home if they: Feel sick or have symptoms of COVID-19 Have been in close contact with someone who is sick or has confirmed COVID-19 in the past 14 days Have returned from travel outside of Canada in the past 14 days Provide multiple snug and comfortable masks (at least 3) for your child, so they have back-ups ready. We suggest separate bags to store clean and dirty masks and a pouch or fanny pack to hold them. Wash cloth masks daily. Review and practice proper hand washing techniques at home, especially before and after eating, sneezing, coughing, and adjusting a mask or cloth face covering. Pack a full water bottle and practice providing a litterless/boomerang lunch and snacks daily. Sharing of food is not allowed and garbage will be sent home to help keep our schools clean. Please remember that lunches cannot be dropped off at school. If you send school supplies, such as crayons and scissors, please store them in a labelled pencil case and inform your child to avoid sharing. Dress your child in **weather appropriate clothing**; they may be spending more time outdoors. Make sure your information is current at school, including emergency contacts and individuals authorized to pick up your child from school. When they are sick, pick up your child promptly. Follow your school's local protocols, including drop off and pick up protocols and using the designated entry doors. Remind your child of **physical distancing** and following the flow of traffic and other measures in place at school. Limit personal belongings being brought to school - students/parents to assess their backpacks for extraneous items daily. Please be **patient and flexible** as we adjust to these new measures to help keep everyone safe.



#### **Elementary Virtual School**

The Elementary Virtual School runs separately from Rouge Park and is staffed with Administrators and teachers from across the system. If any of your children are registered for virtual learning, you should be hearing from an EVS teacher tomorrow by the end of the day tomorrow. Registration for the virtual school is not available at this time. More information regarding any requests will be sent to families directly from the YRDSB. If you have requested a change from F2F (Face-to-Face) to the virtual learning model, all we can do for you at this time is to document your request as part of a waitlist. If you completed the survey for F2F learning, your child has been assigned to a homeroom; therefore, if he/she does not come to school on any of the expected days, please contact Ms. Draper and Ms. Khan, our office secretaries to inform the school of their absence on a daily basis.

#### **Prayer Room**

A reminder to families that we have a **Designated Prayer Space** available at school. Please speak with your child's teacher if your child needs to access this area.

#### **School Assistants:**

We are in need of School Assistants. This is a paid position where you would be **supervising students indoors and outdoors from 12:00-1:00 pm from Monday through Friday**. Health & Safety training and proper PPE would be provided for those interesting in supporting the school as a School Assistant.
