Are you Moving?

If you are planning on moving or have moved, please be sure to contact the office so we have your updated information. If you are no longer in our area, you will need to register in the school closest to your home.

Kindergarten Registration:

Kindergarten Registration for September 2022 will begin on Friday, January 20th. If you have a child who will turn 4 years old before the end of 2023, they are eligible to begin school in September. There are several ways you can register for kindergarten on or after January 20, 2022:

Families can register using the following options:

- Online Families can access the online Kindergarten registration information at www.yrdsb.ca/kindergarten > Registration. It is recommended that families use a laptop or a desktop, rather than a mobile device to complete this registration.
- By email Families can download the <u>Elementary School Registration Form</u> at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/Kindergarten</u> and email the completed form to their school email address.
- By phone Families can request support to complete the registration form on their behalf by collecting the required information by phone. Families can request an interpreter, if needed, during this phone conversation.
- In-person at the school Families may visit the school office to drop off or complete a registration form.

Registration Verification Process

Following submission of a registration package, schools will contact families to schedule an appointment for Document Verification.



Equity Begins at Home (Presentation for Parents/Community) March 30, 2023 @ 6:30 pm



We have booked Dr. ABC (Dr. Andrew Campbell) who is an educator, workshop facilitator, motivational speaker, storyteller and author. You can read Dr. ABC's biography and learn more about him at https://drabc.ca. Here is an overview of the presentation:

Equity issues in schools are at the top of the conversations today. There are many intentional workshops and other forms of engagements that target those within schools - school leaders, classroom teachers, and other stakeholders. These conversations about students and community are often well done, however, what is often lacking, inadequate, or non-existent are the actual conversations with students and community?

This presentation is created for students and the community – this is one of those needed conversations we should be having directly with our students and community. They must also be aware of their own journey into equity, the accountability needed to erase racism and hate in schools, their role as ally and friend, their influence and impact as parents/caregivers within the home, and their responsibility to create and sustain an inclusive school environment.
