Hello Rouge Park Families,

With the beginning of February, we celebrate a focus on Black History Month and Black Excellence. We have a beautiful display in our front entrance that we encourage you to look at if you are visiting the school. As a staff, we continue to engage in learning about the importance of creating identity affirming spaces for all of our students; spaces where they truly feel themselves reflected in the learning. On February 1st we had two interactive presentations with Dr. Andrew Campbell (Dr. ABC). Dr. Campbell spoke of the importance of being a champion for ourselves and others. Dr. ABC spoke to students about ways to put our identity, inclusion and anti-racism learning into action. He provided students with the tools they need to erase racism and hate in schools along with guidance on how to be an ally and a true friend. Staff and student feedback during and after the assemblies was incredibly powerful and heartwarming. We heard comments such as:

"In twenty years of teaching, that was the best presentation I have ever heard." (staff)

"I haven't been feeling good about myself. You reminded me that I am beautiful and I needed to hear that." (grade 5)

"I just need to tell you that your speech changed my entire life." (grade 3)

Together with our School Council and our neighbouring schools, we have booked Dr. ABC for a virtual parent presentation on March 30th. Are you Moving?

If you are planning on moving or have moved, please be sure to contact the office so we have your updated information. If you are no longer in our area, you will need to register in the school closest to your home.

Kindergarten Registration:

Kindergarten Registration for September 2022 will begin on Friday, January 20th. If you have a child who will turn 4 years old before the end of 2023, they are eligible to begin school in September. There are several ways you can register for kindergarten on or after January 20, 2022:

Families can register using the following options:

- Online Families can access the online Kindergarten registration information at www.yrdsb.ca/kindergarten > Registration. It is recommended that families use a laptop or a desktop, rather than a mobile device to complete this registration.
- By email Families can download the <u>Elementary School Registration Form</u> at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/Kindergarten</u> and email the completed form to their school email address.
- By phone Families can request support to complete the registration form on their behalf by collecting the required information by phone. Families can request an interpreter, if needed, during this phone conversation.
- In-person at the school Families may visit the school office to drop off or complete a registration form.

Registration Verification Process

Following submission of a registration package, schools will contact families to schedule an appointment for Document Verification.


