### **School Cash Online:**

We have many new families who have joined our school. If you are new to YRDSB, please follow the instructions on the flyer below or found here: <a href="https://yrdsb.schoolcashonline.com/">https://yrdsb.schoolcashonline.com/</a> to set up an account on School Cash Online. We use this site for most things that involve payments (e.g. school clothing, pizza and pasta days, trips etc.). You will need your child's student number to register. This number can be found on the report card or you can contact your child's teacher or the office.

### Karate:

Northern Karate will once again be offering a 6 week karate class during lunch time at RPPS. Families can sign up for 6 weeks of classes that begin next Tuesday using the QR code on the flyer attached below. Northern Karate donates 100% of the registration fees back to Rouge Park so this ends up being a wonderful fundraiser for our school. Last year the program raised over \$3000.00 for the school. - e) Your child has been added to your account


