Kindergarten Registration:

If you have a child who will turn 4 years old before the end of 2023, they are eligible to begin school in September. There are several ways you can register for kindergarten. We encourage you to register early so that you reserve a spot at RPPS.Families can register using the following options:

- Online Families can access the online Kindergarten registration information at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/kindergarten</u> > Registration. It is recommended that families use a laptop or a desktop, rather than a mobile device to complete this registration.
- By email Families can download the <u>Elementary School Registration Form</u> at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/Kindergarten</u> and email the completed form to their school email address.

By phone - Families can request support to complete the registration form on their behalf • by collecting the required information by phone. Families can request an interpreter, if needed, during this phone conversation.

In-person at the school - Families may visit the school office to drop off or complete a • registration form.
