- a. Scholastic Book Fair Results net sales this year totaled over \$4445 and we were able to enjoy a school profit of just over \$2450. This money will be used by the school to purchase books from Scholastic.
- b. Electronic Copies of Progress Reports sent out by the board November 23 hoping that all the glitches will be worked out before the next set of progress reports are delivered to families.
- c. Grade 3 Gifted Screening -> week of November 29<sup>th</sup> results from Stage 1 testing will be available in January 2023 and any Stage 2 testing will take place after that. Markville District High School will no longer have the Grade 9 and 10 Gifted program. For the 2023-2024 school year it will be offered at Markham District High School.
