



Getting Ready for Kindergarten

• Self help skills

- The Kindergarten team is always here to help and encourage independence
- Practise dressing yourself, using the bathroom on your own (flushing, wiping, washing hands)
- Recognize and write your name





Washroom and Self-Help Routines

- At school, children:
 - Use washroom independently
 - Wash hands with soap
 - Dress and undress
 - Belts, overalls, zippers, buttons
 - Coat, boots, hats, mittens, shoes
