Responsibilities: Attending School Council meetings; Preparing the agenda and sending it to all council members in advance of the meeting. Taking minutes during each meeting and sharing the minutes electronically at the conclusion of each meeting with all council members as well as submitting them, with the agenda, to the school webmaster to be posted on the school website.

Treasurer

Role: Maintain and Keep record of the School Council Monies

Responsibilities: Attending School Council meetings; Collecting and counting of the monies raised by any initiatives of the School Council; Maintaining a second set of records along with the School records; Providing a financial update to the School Council at each meeting

Member at Large (not an executive member position)

Role: Parent members who do not hold a specific role within the council; however, are interested and participate in the working and decisions made collectively by the School Council and support all of its initiatives.

Responsibilities: Attend meetings.
