KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Kindergarten registration for the 2025/2026 school year begins on **Friday, January 17, 2025**. Kindergarten registration is often a family's first encounter with YRDSB schools. The <u>Transition</u> to <u>Kindergarten BWW page</u> and the <u>School Planning Guide</u> are available to support school teams with planning a welcoming and inclusive transition to school process, including registration and spring Discover Kindergarten and Kindergarten Information sessions.

Kindergarten Registration Options for Families

Families can register using the following options:

- Online Families can access the online Kindergarten registration information at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/kindergarten</u> > Registration. It is recommended that families use a laptop or a desktop computer, rather than a mobile device to complete this registration.
- By email Families can download the <u>Elementary School Registration</u> Form at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/kindergarten</u> and email the completed form to their school email address.
- **By phone** Families can request support to complete the registration form on their behalf by collecting the required information by phone. Families can request an interpreter, if needed.
- In-person at the school Families may visit the school office to drop off or complete a registration form.

Information Sessions

Registration

FI registration will begin on January 17, 2025. Parents or guardians of Year 2 Kindergarten students entering Grade 1 in 2024, and wishing to enrol in the FI Program, can email or call their home school office and indicate their intention to enrol. The home school will notify the French Immersion school, and the French Immersion school will contact families by phone or

email to collect any necessary information. Families are asked to register by February 10, 2025. Registration during this period is not first come, first served.

Late Registrations

Late registrations are those submitted after February 10, 2025. Late registrations will be treated on a first-come, first-served basis and will be considered subsequent to registrations received during the registration period should overflow be necessary.
