Late Arrival - We need your help

Help your child start each school day ready to learn! Punctuality is a life-skill that is valued by schools, employers in the work-force, and society. <u>The doors open at 8:15am</u> at Silver Pines. Students can begin to enter the building at this time. <u>The bell rings at 8:30am and students are expected to be in class by this time</u> and if not, will be considered late and will be recorded as such. Please respect your child's precious learning time by scheduling appointments before and after school hours. Arriving late or leaving early affects your child's learning and it is also disruptive for the class.

Cell Phones at School

A reminder about the use of cell phones in school.
