FARSI WORKSHOP - EMOTIONS IN CHECK - APRIL 3

Essential Skills for Parents/Guardians

This event is designed to help parents learn about the education system and practical strategies in regards to emotion regulation and enhance communication skills with their children.

FOOD ALLERGERY PRESENATION – APRIL 9

Food Allergy Canada will be educating students on food allergy and how to stay safe. During this presentation, they will explain what food allergy is, the science behind it and what happens during an anaphylactic reaction. Students will learn how epinephrine works to treat anaphylaxis and how to properly use an auto-injector through a live demonstration using a trainer. Food Allergy Canada will also discuss ways students can be food allergy allies and help keep their friends safe from potential allergic reactions. The assembly will end with a Q&A, giving students the opportunity to ask questions and deepen their understanding.

PASSOVER - APRIL 13 - 20

Passover, also known as Pesach, is the eight-day Jewish Festival that commemorates the emancipation of the Israelites from slavery in ancient Egypt. Passover observances include avoiding leaven and are highlighted by the Seder meals that include four cups of wine, eating matzah and bitter herbs, and the most important aspect of Passover, the teaching of the story of the Exodus to our children. Passover begins at sundown on the first day and ends at nightfall on the eighth day. Passover is celebrated by many Jews across all denominations because it is so essentially and uniquely a family holiday. Wishing all of our students, families and staff celebrating a Happy Passover. VAISAKHI - APRIL 14

For Sikhs, Vaisakhi celebrates the birth of the Panth Khalsa order (the Order of the Pure Ones) established by Guru Gobind Singh in 1699. Vaisakhi is celebrated in April every year. Vaisakhi is celebrated in different parts of India and all around the world.

TRIBAL DANCE VISION PRESENTATION - APRIL 15 - 16

On April 15 and 16 we are excited to welcome Tribal Dance Vision to Silver Pines Public School! Students will explore First Nations history and traditions in Tribal Vision's high-energy performance! RIDVAN - APRIL 20 to MAY 2

The Festival of Ridván (pronounced Riz-wan) commemorates the anniversary of the declaration of Bahá'u'lláh of His prophetic mission to his followers in 1863, proclaiming His identity as the promised Manifestation of God. This is a sacred and celebratory time, and Bahá'ís and their friends come together to remember the life and teachings of Bahá'u'lláh and find ways to serve their community.
