1. Unless specified, exams begin at 9:00 a.m.

- 2. Examination schedules will also be posted in classrooms, in the halls, and in the office. Students should arrive at least fifteen minutes prior to the start of each examination.
- 3. Students cannot be exempted from examinations for activities such as camps, sports events, family holidays or employment. Vacations, jobs, and other planned excursions are to be scheduled outside of the dates indicated on the exam schedule. Any student who misses an exam due to extenuating circumstances (medical emergency, court appearance, bereavement) must call the school immediately, 905-326-7994 and provide proper documentation (medical certificate, court subpoena, death certificate). These students will be required to write an examination at the end of the schedule in order to demonstrate course expectations. Students who are ill and cannot be present for an examination must provide a medical note as soon as possible and an examination will be scheduled. Students who miss an examination for other reasons will receive a mark of zero for the examination portion of their final mark.
- 4. The school code of conduct and the YRDSB Caring and Safe Schools Policy continue to be in effect during the exam period.
- 5. Students are expected to take care of their personal washroom needs prior to the start of the exam.
- 6. Students arriving late for an examination must report directly to Room 102 to seek further directions/instructions.
- 7. Students will be asked to sign an attendance sheet in each examination signifying their presence in the examination.
- 8. Students are not allowed to leave the exam room before the exam is officially over.
- 9. Students are responsible to ensure they bring all necessary equipment such as pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, and mathematical sets. A spare pen is highly recommended.
- 10. Students must not leave their seats during the examination. If more paper is needed or a question needs to be clarified, the student shall raise a hand and wait for the supervising teacher to assist.
- 11. Music and listening devices, phones and other personal electronic devices are not permitted.
- 12. Coats, notebooks, backpacks, handouts, phones and electronic devices are to be left at the front of the classroom.
- 13. Textbooks are to be brought into the exam room for collection by the teacher. If any textbook that was assigned is lost or damaged, the student will be required to reimburse the school before any new material can be loaned for the next semester.
- 14. The cafeteria will be available for students as a study area during the examination period. The library will NOT be available as exams are being written there.
- 15. In the event of the cancellation of an exam day due to inclement weather, the cancelled exams will be moved to **Thursday, February 1 at the same time and in the same classroom. All subsequent exams will be written on their originally scheduled day and time.
