- Sept 22-23 University fair downtown at Metro Convention Centre for all Ontario. Local Postsecondary fair – November 1st hosted at Alexander Mackenzie High School for all local secondary schools (Westmount, Alex Mac, Maple, Thornhill, Thornlea)
