Vice Principals Report - Elisa Shiffman:

- OSSLT for grade 10 is on hold for now
- EQAO for grade 9 is paused for this year
- Grade 12 grad waiting on further information

Principals Report - Paolo Burzese:

- Students and parents received survey
- Changing the way the day is setup
 - No control at school level
- Senior team at board
 - o Paolo sat in on the meeting
 - Came away with things that work and don't work
- Balancing face-to-face time
 - Seems to be working well
 - o Good procedures we have in place
 - Students enjoy the part of being in school
- Start up of semester 2
 - Built in some breaks in class
 - Teachers go for walks about a dozen classes go for a walk per day
 - Current model approved by the ministry and we are sticking to it for second semester
- Classroom building face-to-face and online
 - Students very attentive
 - Interact more on a safe online environment
 - Start pushing ahead to get through the curriculum
- 1,700 students enrolled at school
 - About 1,290 students in building for semester 2
 - About 430 students online for semester 2
- 60 courses removed from timetable
 - Means a lot of movement including staff movement
 - Will get it covered in the next few weeks
- 5 period day
 - o Moved to a 4 period day to align with the rest of the board
 - Timetable changes
- Volunteer hours
 - Number of hours changed to 20

- More flexibility of what can be done
- o Paid job some hours can be used
- o Tutoring at home can be used
- Students can't go to certain places
- If unsure reach out to guidance

Council - Question and Answer:

• Peer tutoring

- Happening this year through guidance
- Sent out through social media

• Grad and prom

- No decision has been made
- o Can't imagine a scenario to have in person grad/prom
- Virtual grad ceremony was a couple of weeks ago for last years students

Attendance

- Looks different
- Challenge is with P.M. classes
- Some students log on for 10 minutes and then disappear or stay logged on but when the teacher calls on them, they are not present

• Cameras on for students

- Working on this
- o Some students may be uncomfortable with their home or may not have a camera
- You want students to feel safe to turn on their camera
- Hoping to build on this, i.e., turn on once a week
- Voluntary from students, not board mandate

Honor roll

- No decision has been made yet regarding last years honour roll
- Challenge is the second half of the year
- Marks were from the first 2 weeks and then lockdown fell into place

Yearbook

- No plans to do yearbook as we don't have the means to make it happen
- Perhaps grade 12 will have a yearbook
- The challenge is collecting photos, etc.
- A couple of teachers offered to help
- No definite answer
- Board asked to move slowly

Clubs

- Online clubs got permission a month ago
- In a month or so more clubs will start
- Question is how to start clubs online that were in person

- York Region not running sports
- Can you take grade 12 courses in grade 11?
 - Not always recommended as students aren't always ready

Guidance Report - Marisa Ellis:

- Volunteer hours
 - o 20 hours to graduate
 - Allowed 10 hours of paid employment fill out a reflection question
 - Profit making not acceptable
 - Utilize some hours if tutoring neighbour's child, snow shoveling, etc. speak to Ms. Ellis
 - After this year we are back to 40 hours, but can also submit 10 hours of paid employment
- Looking to next semester
 - Staff working on building a community in class
 - o Built in breaks, etc.
 - Start semester slower, so students understand expectations
- Lack of social connection you don't see many students due to the pandemic
- Universities
 - Looking purely at marks
 - High profile programs (sciences and engineering) at Waterloo and University of Toronto won't accept private school marks
 - No change in entry marks at any university due to Covid-19
 - Mid-term marks submission is new this year due to Covid-19
 - You can call the university directly if you have further questions
- Hoping second semester will go smoother as we are learning from first semester
