

YRDSB Land Acknowledgement Statement-

NEWLY REVISED.....



The Land Acknowledgement Statement has been revised to include a new paragraph which helps us understand the importance of the TRUTH & RECONCILIATION CALLS TO ACTION—# 62 & 63

Treaties were negotiated at the beginning of relationships between the Indigenous peoples and early settlers.

Treaties are living agreements, which are recognized and respected today.

We would like to start by acknowledging that we are on the traditional territories of the Wendat, the Haudenosaunee, and the Anishinaabe peoples, whose presence here continues to this day.

We also would like to acknowledge this is the treaty lands of the First Nations of the Williams Treaty and thank them and other Indigenous peoples for sharing this land with us.

We would like to acknowledge the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation as our closest community and partners in education.

We acknowledge this land and the people because the first step to reconciliation is recognizing the existence of Indigenous people.

The Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada Calls to Action (number 62 - 63) speak to the significance of education as the key to reconciliation.

A shared understanding of how our collective past brought us to where we are today will help us walk

together into a better future.

Student Transportation Information 2018—2019

Please be aware of the following :-

Student Transportation Services of York Region (STSYR) provides transportation service in accordance with the policies of

its member School Boards, the York Region District School Board (YRDSB) and the York Catholic District School Board (YCDSB)

Students may be eligible for transportation if their primary address is located within their home school attendance area and <u>is further than the following distances</u>:

Grades JK to Gr. 3 1.2 km's

Grades 4 to 8 1.6 km's

<u>**Transportation:**</u> Students may be transported in exceptional circumstances within a school Non-Transportation Zone. This is an area designated by Board policy as ineligible for school vehicle transportation. This may include service for students with special needs and students with documented medical conditions from a certified medical practitioner.



The Grade 6 (NEW), Grade 7, and Grade 8 Literacy & Math Program is designed for students who fall into at least *one* of the following categories:

- performing below the provincial standard;
- disengaged from learning and would benefit from an Arts Integrated, Inquiry Based program;
- have poor attendance (20+ absences on end of year attendance report);
- have social-emotional behavior/environment challenges that create barriers to their learning; and/or
- have an IEP or is an ELL, Stage 1 or 2.

The Grade 8 Reach Ahead Program is specifically designed for students who:

- would benefit from a gradual transition into high school;
- may experience some challenges in credit acquisition in grade 9 or 10;
- would benefit from focused support in order to improving his/her academic performance;
 - may be disconnected from school and/or peers;
- has experienced some challenges with regular school attendance.

<u>All Grade 6, Grade 7 and Grade 8 students will need to register on-line for</u> <u>summer school using Career Cruising by June 8, 2018.</u>
