Early Dismissal in YRDSB Elementary Schools

All schools in the York Region District School Board are committed to improving student achievement and well-being. On Thursday, June 27, 2019, an early release day will take place to allow elementary teachers and support staff to take part in meetings during the afternoon of that day. These meetings will allow for school staff to engage in culminating activities regarding the review and revision of the School's Improvement Plan as well as year-end and transition activities that support student success.

As has been our practice in the past, students will attend school during the morning of Thursday, June 27, 2019 only. Students will be dismissed early that day at 11:55 am. Arrangements will be made to ensure that students who are normally bused to and from school will receive transportation at this time. Parents/guardians whose children attend after school child care should make appropriate arrangements to address this change in schedule.

All Students will be dismissed at 11:55 am. Please pick your child up at 11:55 a. m.

## Grades 6, 7 & 8 SUMMER SCHOOL

The York Region District School Board will once again be offering a Grade 6, 7 & 8 Summer School program. This 14 day program is designed to reinforce curriculum. Students must register in the program for their current school grade as this is not an acceleration program. For example, a grade 7 student would register for the grade 7 program as it reinforces grade 7 content.

The program will operate from July 2 to July 19, 2019 (8:45 am - 3:25 pm). Please note that Keswick H.S. times are 8:45 am - 3:33 pm. A typical day has Language and Numeracy instruction in the morning with Arts based programming in the afternoon. There are both lunch and recess breaks during the day. Students will need to bring a lunch, snacks and plenty to drink each day.

The following programs will be offered:

- Language and Math reinforcement for students who do not have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) or an English Language Learner (ELL) designation.
- Language and Math reinforcement for students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP).
  - English Language Learner (ELL) Language for students who are ELL Stage 1 or 2 learners. The focus is on reading, writing and speaking.

Registration forms are available on YRDSB's website: <a href="www.yrdsb.ca">www.yrdsb.ca</a>. Children who turn four or five years old during 2019, live within the school boundary and whose parents are public school tax supporters will be eligible to register for kindergarten.

#### SCHOOL PARKING NOTE TO ALL PARENTS

**In the morning...** Please pull as far ahead as possible to allow others to enter. Dropping your children off on Stonebridge Drive is not safe and hold up traffic in the morning. There is NO PARKING on Stonebridge Drive or Wilfred Murison Avenue between 8:30 am to 930 am. With everyone's cooperation, we can make our Kiss & Ride drop off in the morning safe and efficient. 早上,請盡量往最前停讓孩子下車,孩子在大街下車絕不安全及阻礙交通,早上八時三十分到九時三十分,是不能在Stonebridge 或 Wilfred Murison大街停車。請大家合作,以確保安全和快捷。

If you are dropping off a lunch for your child, please pull up as far as possible in the Kiss & Ride. Please DO NOT PARK in the Kiss & Ride for any length of time. 中午送午餐, 請盡量往最前停, 好讓其他車進入, 不要停泊長時間。

**After school**...Please pull ahead as far as possible so that others can enter the parking lot. If picking up your child in the Kiss & Ride, please remain in your car and pull ahead as far as possible. Do not leave your vehicle. 放學時間, 請盡量往最前停, 好讓其他車進入。等候孩子,不可停下離開汽車。

There is **NO PARKING** on Stonebridge Drive or Wilfred Murison Avenue between 3:00 pm and 4:00 pm. You can ONLY park on the side streets. Waiting for your child on Stonebridge Drive or Wilfred Murison Avenue is not safe and restricts traffic and we don't want any of our families to get costly tickets for parking illegally on Stonebridge Drive or Wilfred Murison Avenue. 下午三時至四時,不能停泊在 Stonebridge 或 Wilfred Murison 大街等候孩子,只可停在内街,為孩子安全,避免阻礙交通或接到告票,請遵守交通規則。
