A Message from the Administration

We hope that all of our families are doing well, and that you and your family are keeping safe during this time. These are unprecedented times, and our staff have been working to ensure that all of our students are engaged in the distance learning that is taking place and connecting with families to support where needed. As was announced on April 26th, we will continue with our distance learning until May 29th until we receive further direction from the Ministry of Education about whether schools will open at that point. Our school board is communicating directly with families by email and through text notifications, and the York Region DSB website and Twitter feed contain the most recent updates for families about school closures, programming and supports.

We have had a number of requests for students to access their belongings. At this point students are unable to access their belongings at school as per the direction of Public Health and the Ministry of Education.

Please describe your child's learning profile and the type of teaching style that will support your child (e.g. My child requires a lot of structure, My child learns best through the Arts, my child is strong in Literacy but needs more support in Math etc.).


