In and Around Stonebridge:

Some activities and initiatives started by the students and staff of the Stonebridge Public School recently were discussed - some of the activities included:

- 1) Forest of Gratitude -elementary school students showed their appreciation by decorating a wall with a leaf
- 2) Support for the LGBT Community a day where many decided to wear purple to show their support for the LGBT Community - there was a pledge wall created to help promote equity and inclusivity
- 3) Active Cycling Pop up held on Oct 8th parents and students were given a basic demo on bike tune up and safety this was also done to encourage families to walk to school on Wednesdays, details of which will be discussed later on.
- 4) Markham Food Bank a student of StoneBridge Public School worked in collaboration with the Markham Food Bank and collected non perishable food items a goal of \$8,000 was set and the target was met within a course of 2 weeks only.
- 5) **Kiss and Ride Closure** in order to encourage families to walk to school, an active walk to school campaign has been started in which families are encouraged to walk to school every Wednesday it is also called the Walking Wednesday Campaign. The next Walk to School Wednesday will be observed on Nov 10th and Kiss and Ride will be closed on this day. The main purpose of this campaign is to encourage more active

and sustainable travel to and from school and to reduce vehicle congestion. 6 new schools in Newmarket have expressed their interest in joining the program.
