3. Staff Report - George and Melissa

4. Update on Safe and Caring Schools - George

George shared a presentation that was delivered to students at YRDSB. Key points from the presentation and student learnings are noted below:

- Safe language, kind words, safe hands and feet
- Respectful and inclusive language
- Help students learn how to have healthy relationships
- Discussion of online presence and managing reputation
- Progressive discipline process in depth process which may include discussions with students, review of camera footage, establishing findings, conflict resolution and restorative work, offer services of social worker, suspend when necessary and in consultation with superintendent and other partners
- Report it function
- Access to Kids Help Phone

Discussion on how this information will be shared with families. Excerpts of the information will be shared through the school newsletter with consideration for translating this information into multiple languages.
