3. Staff Report - Tim Dunn, Monika Dogra & Melissa Boulet

- Past events:
 - o Terry Fox Run raised \$1300.00
 - Orange Shirt Day September 30, 2021, first time participating in Truth and Reconciliation, YRDSB released a virtual event for Junior and Intermediate students
 - o School library is now open
 - Students participating in story walk
 - Cross country team is currently practicing, typically there would be a meet with other schools, this year that is not possible, Mr. Farr is working hard to replicate cross country like environment
 - o Safety Week practiced lock downs (different in COVID times), fire drills
 - Walk to School Day October 6
 - Staff Professional Development: COVID 19 best practices, hybrid learning, compliance training, anti-black racism training, workshop on autism spectrum disorder, mental health awareness module
- Upcoming events:
 - o Virtual Open House October 13, 2021
 - o Staff Development: use of electronic communication and social media use
 - Asynchronous Learning Day October 15, 2021, activities/learning posted in google classroom, purpose for staff to do some professional development about hybrid learning
 - Cross country Stonehaven will be hosting a school cross-country meet (date TBD)
- Tim thanked 2020-2021 School Council and parent volunteers for their commitment and contributions to the school on behalf of staff

- Staffing report staffing is based on projections prepared by YRDSB planning, currently 635 students (more than projected), hard to predict the number of students each year, re-organization K-4 classes and hiring of new teacher, Board reinstated ESL and reading recovery time, started with 24 classes and now at 25 classes, majority of classes are in hybrid model, class model can change at any time, students who need to self-isolate can participate in remote learning
- Commend the staff for supporting transitions for students
- Stonehaven School participating in Active School Travel pilot to reduce traffic congestion, YRDSB and Town of Newmarket partnered to paint curbs red to promote road safety, encourage students to walk or bike to school
