Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements: 40 hours of community involvement, a completed literacy requirement and 30 credits including:

- 1 Arts credit (drama, music, visual arts) recommended to take in grade 9 or 10
- 1 Technology credit (must be taken in grade 9 or 10)
- 1 Health & Physical Education credit (any grade)
- A minimum of 12 optional credits
- 1 credit from **Group 1** 1 additional credit in English, or French, or a Classical or International Language, or a Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance and Career education, or Co-operative Education**
- 1 credit from **Group 2** 1 additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or Business Studies, or the Arts (music, art, or drama), or French, or Co-operative Education**
- 1 credit from **Group 3** 1 additional credit in Science (Grade 11 or 12), Computer Studies or Technological Education (Grades 9-12), French*, or Co-operative Education**

A maximum of 3 credits in English as a second language (ESL) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit earned in a Grade 12 compulsory English course.

^{*} A maximum of 2 credits in French.

^{**}A maximum of 2 credits in Co-operative Education can count as compulsory credits; this may include up to four credits achieved through approved Dual Credit courses.
